#### A. Update on meeting sponsorship

CIRA, Verisign, and Huawei all chose to keep their sponsorships for IETF 107. The other sponsors have deferred to a future meeting or have an annual contract. Discussions with all sponsors are ongoing and in a good place.

#### B. Update on financial & insurance implications of canceling in-person meeting(s)

The IETF is well covered by insurance, including full pandemic/epidemic coverage for all meetings in 2020. Discussions are ongoing with the hotel to determine if we will rebook for a future meeting or receive a refund. Agreements are in place with all meeting services vendors. The LLC will be working closely with the IESG to determine next steps for IETF 108 and 109.

#### C. How is the virtual meeting working so far?

General consensus is that the virtual meeting is working well, pending results of a meeting survey which will yield more data.

#### D. Are there technical gaps we need to fill/fund before the next IETF?
